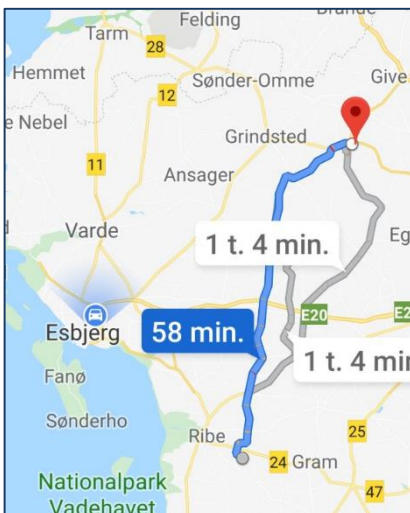

## WHAT CAN WE OFFER?

### The rooms

The college has attractive, bright single rooms, each with its own toilet and bath. They are equipped with a bed, desk, office chair, small bookcase and cupboard for your clothes. There is also a TV and free wifi in the rooms.

Bedlinen can be changed every second Thursday and towels every Thursday.

You are responsible for cleaning your room yourself. There is a vacuum cleaner and other cleaning material in the laundry room. Check the fire instructions which are on the wall in the room.



### Food and the canteen

The canteen is in two parts – one for our resident course participants, where the food is served, and one for our day students, where food can be purchased.

The daily refreshments consist of

- **Breakfast buffet**
- **Mid-morning coffee**  
Can be obtained in the canteen, with pastries or bread also available for purchase
- **Lunch buffet**
- **Afternoon coffee**  
Set out in the college corridor
- **Dinner**  
Buffet with cold and warm dishes
- **Evening coffee**  
Set out in the college corridor with pastries or cake

Is it urgent, call +45 25 24 09 60 outside opening hours. If it isn't urgent, send a text - remember to include your name and room number.

## Arrival and departure

You can arrive at the college from 19.00 on Sunday.

The college is manned on Sunday from 19.00-21.00.

On the last day of school, you should pack your things and put out the rubbish before 08.00. Put your bed linen and towels in the laundry cart outside the laundry. You can put your luggage in the room at the main entrance area (the room is unlocked, so this is at your own risk).

## Guests

Guests are very welcome at the college – visits can be made from 16.00-23.00. If your guests would like to eat with you, just let the kitchen know – there will also be a charge for this.

It is not usually possible for guests to stay overnight, but we can make exceptions in a few cases – ask the course secretary.

## Sickness

If you fall ill during your stay at the college, or cannot take part in the lectures, let the course secretary know, no later than 08.00.



## HOUSE RULES FOR THE COLLEGE

### A few notes about your stay at the college

We naturally expect that all users of the college will treat it with respect. The following rules apply to ALL USERS

### SHOW CONSIDERATION



#### Smoking

Smoking is only allowed outside at the designated places with ash trays, which **MUST** be used. There is a smoking room next to the main entrance area. Smoking in the room is not allowed. A breach of this rule leads to an additional charge of DKK 1,500 for deep cleaning of the room.



#### Noise

You can listen to music and chat, so long as it does not disturb others. The period from 23.00-07.00 should be quiet.



#### Alcohol

May be drunk after school hours, and may **NOT** lead to disturbance for the other residents.



#### Drugs

Possession of narcotics will lead to expulsion.



#### Weapons

Possession of weapons or other breaches of law will lead to expulsion.



#### Pets

Pets are not permitted.
